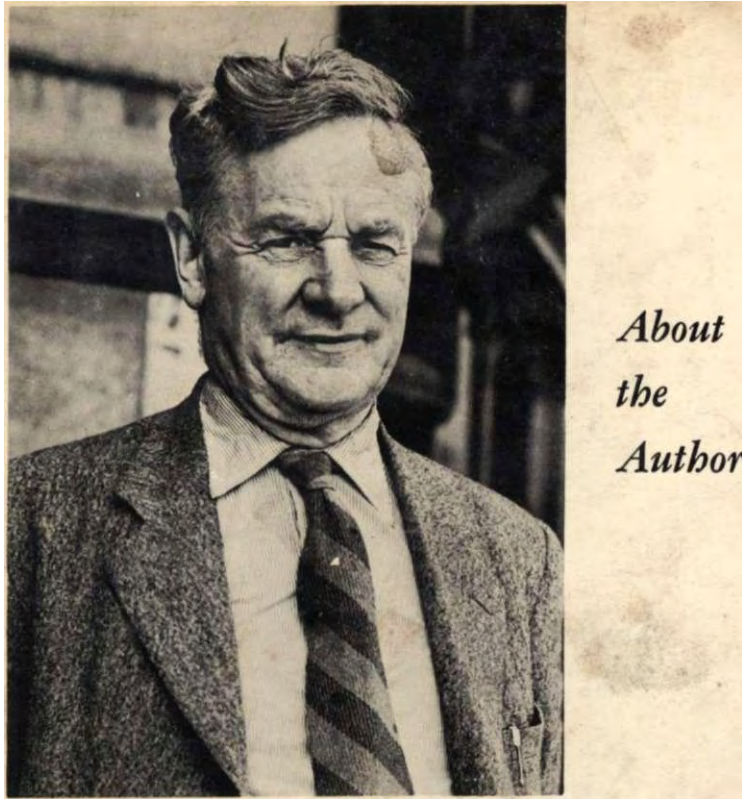

EMHYS HUGHES, born in Tonypany, South Wales, has lived in Scotland for more than twenty-five years. In February, 1946, he was elected to represent the district of South Ayrshire in Parliament. In addition to this book, Mr. Hughes has written a biography of Keir Hardie, the British labor leader. His *The Crown and the Cash* was published at the time of the Coronation and created widespread controversy.
